Primary Responsibilities

- Develop an outreach vision and actionable strategy that identifies and engages diverse community partner groups and sectors (parents, businesses, nonprofits, associations, government entities, higher education, etc.)
- Coordinate strategy and planning with Pima CommunityShare staff
- Create presentations, flyers and other materials to share with community partners
- Identify and recruit new community partners based on requests from educators
- Connect with potential partners via phone, email, coffee, etc. every week and set a weekly target based on your Implementation plan
- Organize in-person and virtual events that invite community partners to join Pima CommunityShare and attend other organization's community events to build new relationships with potential partners
- Present to community partners and assist them as needed to create their online profile
- Utilize the CommunityShare platform to track usage, educator requests for partnerships, partner offers, and follow up on requirements for partnering with an educator (e.g. screening and training)
- Advise community partners who want to engage on longer-term projects with schools
- Design and maintain systems of recognition and gratitude for community partners
- Document engagements between partners, educators and youth through photography and/or other media formats
- Share photographs and stories with the Director of Communications for distribution
- Create an e-newsletters that highlights stories of impact and opportunities for engagement
- Collect and analyze impact data as appropriate
- Share regional progress updates and evaluation results with key stakeholders (educators, community partners, Pima CommunityShare staff, funders, etc.)
- Co-manage with Pima CommunityShare staff a small grants program to support projects

- As needed, recruit and supervise volunteers and interns who can assist with community and educator engagement
